The works must be completed within 12 months from the date below or such further period as this Court may allow and the certificate of practical completion is to be sent to the Registry within the period allowed.


A copy of this further order is to be supplied by you to the architect or surveyor and contractors to be employed in respect of the authorised work before any work is commenced.

Tuning of the 7th bell.

The work consists of the tuning of the 7th bell of the bell tower of the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit, located in the town of Opatowitz, in the district of Opatowitz, in the region of South Moravia. The work is to be carried out by the contractor in accordance with the conditions set out in the tender documents. The work is to be completed within 12 months from the date below or such further period as this Court may order and the certificate of practical completion is to be sent to the Registry within the period allowed.

A copy of this further order is to be supplied by you to the contractor in accordance with the conditions set out in the tender documents. The contractor is to be held responsible in respect of the execution of the work and the contractor is to be held responsible for the completion of the work.
